## **REGISTERING IS QUICK & EASY**

#### STEP 1

Visit www.clevnet.org and click on My Account. LOG IN – The first time you do so, type your library card number in the Username or Barcode box and your PIN in the Password box. Do not include the initial "A" in your library card number.

**Your Account:** Under **My Borrowing** you will find items you have checked out, on hold, and a list of fines.


